2020 Data in Duval County

24.4% of new HIV diagnoses occurred in women.

36.4% of new AIDS diagnoses occurred in women.

2,208 women live with HIV.

1,228 women live with AIDS.

Heterosexual contact is the biggest risk factor for women contracting HIV.

18.8% of women with HIV did not receive treatment last year.

Changing the face of HIV



- Testing is the only way to know if you are HIV+
- Any woman who has sex is at risk of HIV, no matter her race, ethnicity, or age
- Protect yourself and your partner every time by using a condom
- If you do not have HIV and your partner does, talk to your doctor about pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP). PrEP is a daily pill that can reduce your risk of getting HIV
- Never share needles, syringes, or other injection equipment
- Fight the stigma! Support your friends and living with HIV or AIDS
